2023 CRCHA Tulare Spring Shoot Out Presented by WeldCraft Industries

- Moved from November to May
- No changes (same 4 day format as 2022)



2023 CRCHA Tulare Fall Presented by CR Hes A Tuff One & Red Arrow Ranch Home of Roo To Do

- Futurity minimum \$40,000 added
- Derby minimum \$25,000 added
- Horse show \$7,850 added
- 5 day format (3 days futurity & derby, 2 days horse show) Classic



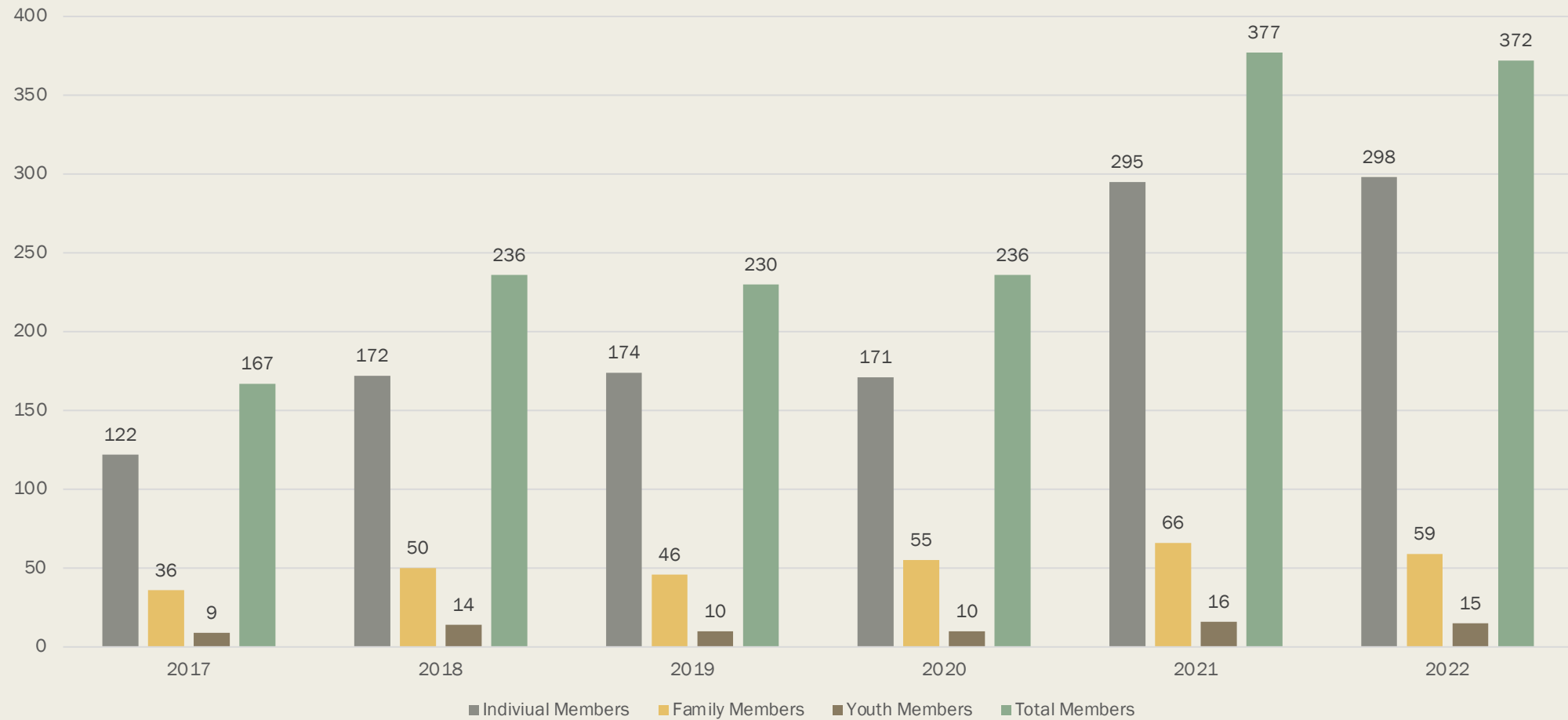
2023 Horse Show Changes

- Class changes
 - CRCHA Non pro hackamore added
 - CRCHA Ltd non pro bridle replaced by level 1 non pro bridle & eligibility (due to NRCHA rule change)
- Total added money increased from \$7,150 to \$7,850 (+\$700)
 - LOB from \$250 to \$300 (+\$50)
 - INPB from \$250 to \$325 (+\$75)
 - L1NPB from \$200 to \$275 (+\$75)
 - LOH from \$250 to \$300 (+\$50)
 - NPH from \$250 to \$400 (+\$150)
 - OTR from \$350 to \$500 (+\$150)
 - NPTR from \$250 to \$400 (+\$150)

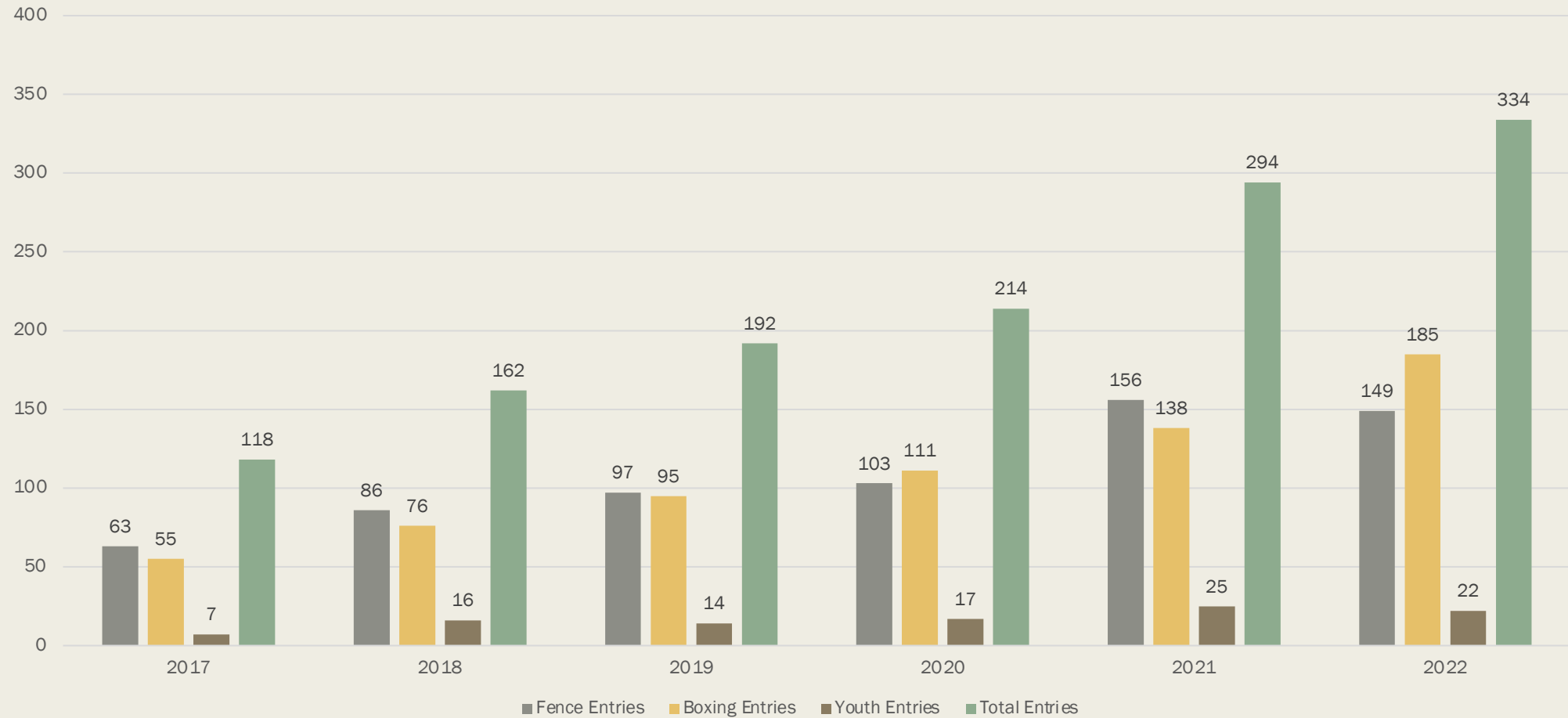
2023 NRCHA Show Related Rules Changes

- Earnings rules & definitions (no change, for reference in following changes)
 - Rule 3.2 “Lifetime earnings” are considered as all monies won at NRCHA Approved Horse Shows, Limited Age Events, Category 1 Special Events, and Category 2 Special Events
 - “Open and non pro monies” exclude youth and non pro boxing earnings
- Open eligibility earnings limits are based on open and non pro monies (was lifetime earnings excluding youth and non pro boxing in 2021, same meaning just different wording)
- Non pro eligibility earnings limits are based on open and non pro monies (was lifetime earnings excluding youth and non pro boxing in 2021 , same meaning just different wording)
- Open 3 year earnings list is based on open money (was based on lifetime earnings in 2021)
- Non pro 3 year earnings list is based on open and non pro money (was based on lifetime earnings in 2021)
- Non pro boxing eligibility limits are based on lifetime earnings
- Limited non pro bridle is replaced by level 1 non pro bridle, earnings limit is \$15,000 in open and non pro monies and there is no fall back
- Regional and national standings are final at the end of the show year (no points earned at world championship)
- There is a 2 point rein work penalty for failure to hesitate at the end of the pattern

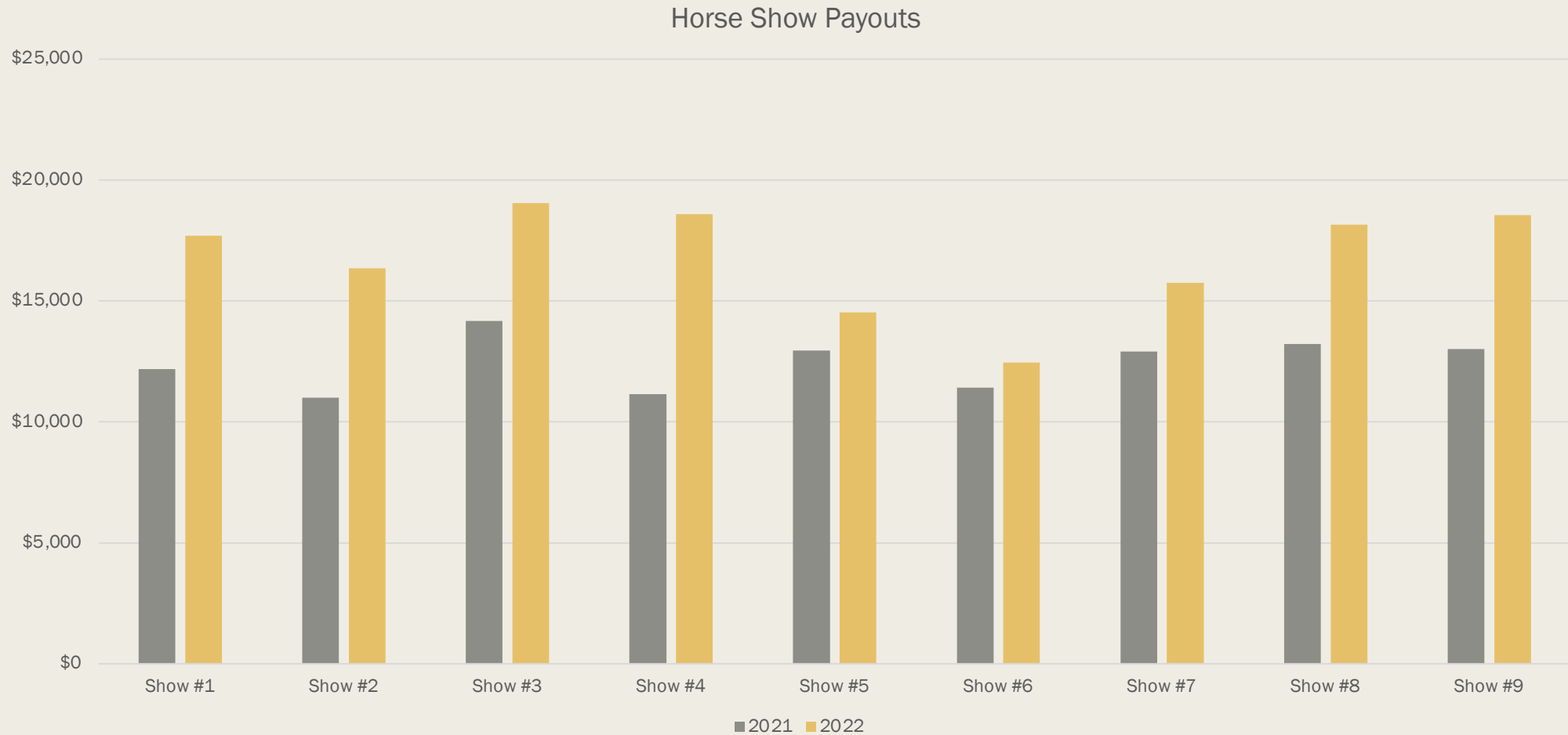

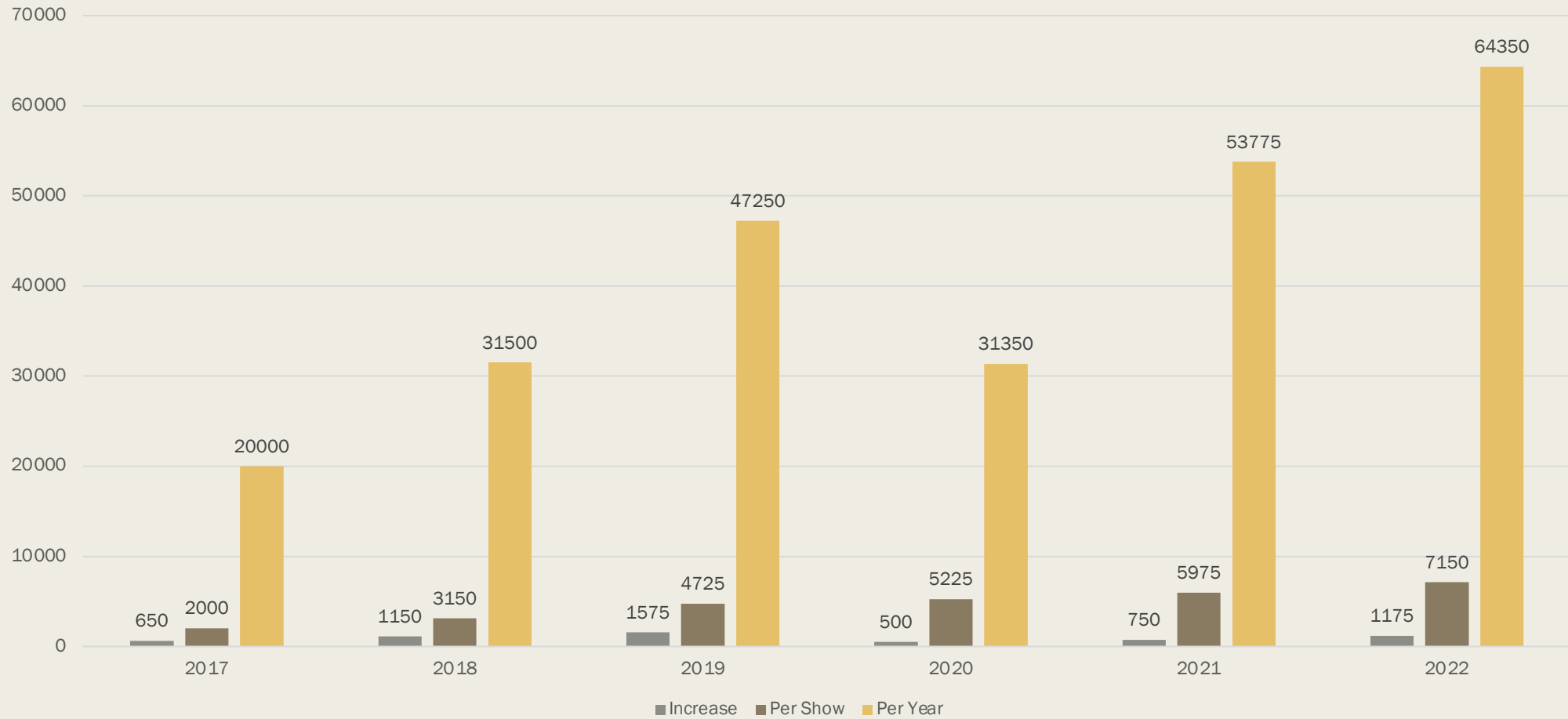
Horse Show Entries



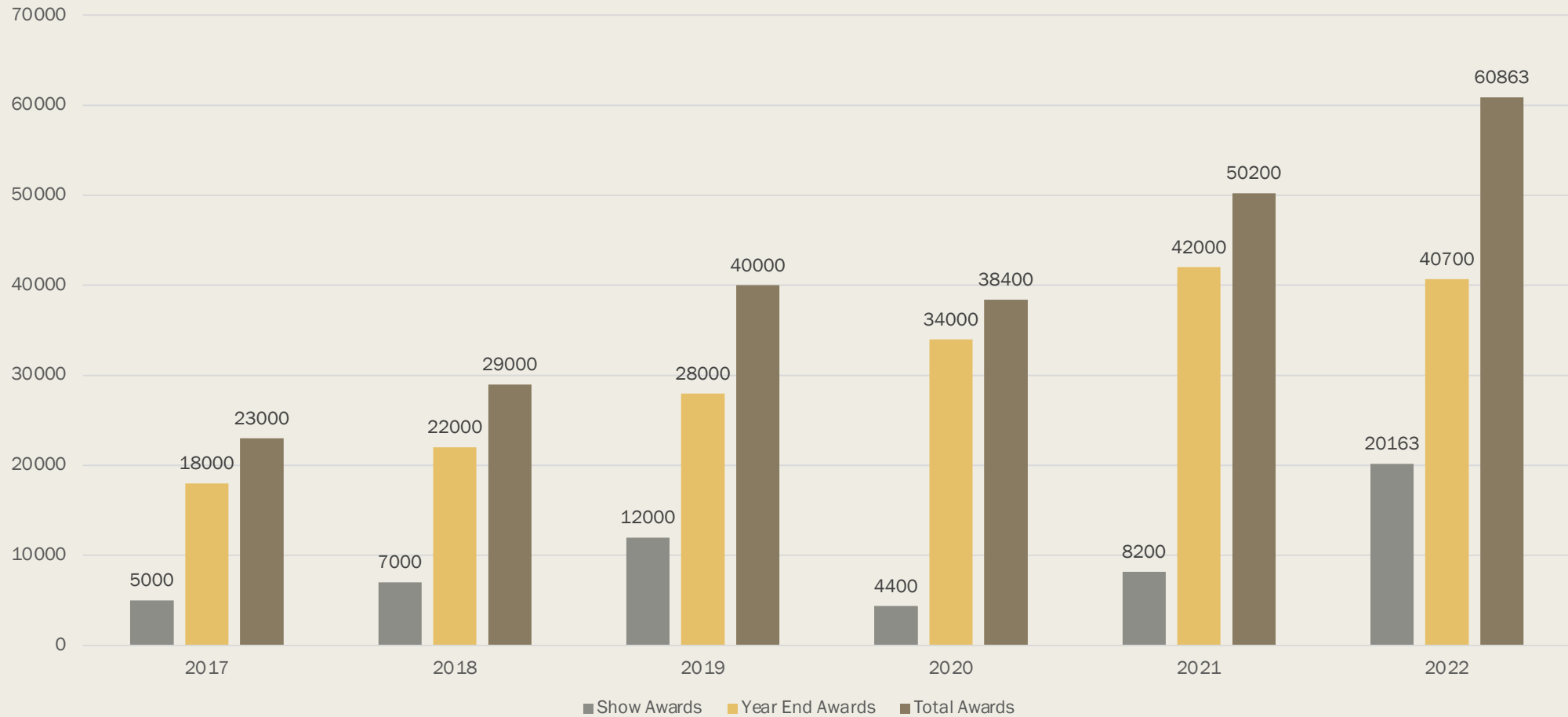
Horse Show Payouts

2023 Expense Increases

- Paso Robles facility & stall rental cost increases per signed 5 year contract
- Tulare facility & equipment rental cost increases per draft 5 year contract
- Labor cost increases
- Cattle & feed cost increases
- Liability insurance coverage cost increase
- General operating cost increases

2023 Fee Increases

- Paso Robles and Tulare haul In fee \$25 (+\$10)
- Paso Robles January & February stalls \$75 (+\$5)
- Paso Robles April special event stalls \$225 (+\$30) & weekend stalls \$175 (+\$25)
- Paso Robles & Tulare shavings per bag \$15 (+\$3)
- Paso Robles RVs per day \$45 (+\$5)
- Paso Robles and Tulare horse show judge & office fee \$30 each (+\$5 each)
- Paso Robles derby judge fee \$90 (+\$15) & spectacular judge fee \$60 (+\$10)
- Tulare futurity & derby judge fee \$90 (+\$15)
- 3-Event cattle fee \$300 (+\$50)

2023 CRCHA Bylaws & Rules Changes

- Bylaws
 - Rewording for improved clarity
- Rules
 - NRCHA & CRCHA L1NPB class replaces LNPB (per NRCHA rule change)
 - CRCHA NPH class added
