Rules & Important Dates

- Futurity, derby & horse show entries close midnight Sunday October 29
- Futurity & derby late entry fee \$100, horse show late entry fee \$30 (after midnight Sunday October 29)
- Futurity & derby late entries accepted up to midnight Sunday November 5 *
- Open junior horse late entries accepted up to noon Tuesday November 7
- Saturday horse show classes late entries accepted up to noon Friday November 10 **
- Sunday horse show classes late entries accepted up to noon Saturday November 11 **
- Ranch branding entries accepted up to 5 pm Friday November 10
- Owner & rider must be current CRCHA member in good standing to enter NRCHA or CRCHA class
- Owner & rider must be current NRCHA member in good standing to enter NRCHA class
- Exhibitor is responsible for eligibility to compete in the classes entered according to the guidelines set forth in the NRCHA & CRCHA rulebooks
- Cross entries in more than one class in a highlighted group pay only one cattle fee
- Each group of highlighted classes drawn & run concurrently
- Scratch after cattle ordered forfeits cattle fee
- Scratch after draw forfeits add back, office & cattle fees

* For futurity and derby late entries received after the draw (noon Saturday November 4) NRCHA rules 9.4.1.1-9.4.1.3, 9.5 and 9.6 will apply

General Information

REQUIRED HEALTH DOCUMENTS – The California Department of Food and Agriculture requires a health certificate (Certificate of Veterinary Inspection) dated within 30 days and proof of a negative equine infectious anemia test (Coggins or ELISA) dated within 12 months for out of state horses entering California. See [CDFA website](#) for details. Show management does not require health certificates or Coggins for any horses attending the event.

Ranch Branding

- 4 riders per team, 1 rider must be entered in show, each rider may enter up to 3 teams
- Team entry fee \$300 cash or credit
- Outside riders must purchase \$25 day membership fee (insurance requires all participants to be members)
- 2 head roped in full arena, time stops when both head have been headed, heeled, laid down and touched on either flank by a team member, head rope must go on first, legal head catches include neck or neck and a front leg, a full figure eight must be removed, unnecessary roughness will result in no time, any infractions will result in disqualification, judge's decision is final
- 100% of entry fee will go to the payout. Day membership fee does not go to the payout
- Payout in cash at conclusion of branding, paid out according to NRCHA rule 7.2 based on number of teams entered
- Enter at show, entries close 2 hours prior to start of branding
