#### **HEALTH DOCUMENTS**

The California Department of Food and Agriculture requires a health certificate (Certificate of Veterinary Inspection) dated within 30 days and proof of a negative equine infectious anemia test (Coggins or ELISA) dated within 12 months for out of state horses entering California. See CDFA website for details. Show management does not require health certificates or Coggins for any horses attending the event.

## STALLS, BEDDING & FEED

#### **STALLS - \$250**

The deadline to order stalls is midnight Friday November 1, 2024.

A stall list will be posted on the CRCHA website by November 4, 2024. Please specify your preferred stall location and we will do our best to satisfy your request, 168 permanent stalls available filled in order received, remaining in temporary stalls.

#### **BEDDING**

\$15 minimum 2 bags per stall (tack stalls excepted), pre-order on entry form to guarantee availability, post-orders available on site as supplies last (no outside bedding allowed)

#### **FEED**

Hay is available for purchase on site as supplies last. Market price per bale. Contact the Show Secretary in the Show Office. Delivered by Grounds Manager.

#### **HAUL IN**

If you haul in and do not need a stall, there is a day fee of \$25 per horse per day

## **PAYOUTS & SHOW RULES**

#### **FUTURITY & DERBY OPEN\***

Futurity and Derby Open entries are automatically entered into open divisions for which they are eligible (Intermediate Open, Limited Open). 70% of entry fee will go to the payout.

#### **FUTURITY & DERBY L1 OPEN\***

Futurity and Derby Level 1 Open can be entered as its own class. 70% of entry fee will go to the payout.

#### **FUTURITY & DERBY NON PRO\***

Futurity and Derby Non Pro entries are automatically entered into Non Pro divisions for which they are eligible (Intermediate Non Pro, Limited Non Pro). 70% of entry fee will go to the payout.

\*Number of places paid in futurity and derby will be determined by NRCHA rule 7.2.

#### **HORSE SHOW**

Horse show payouts will follow rule 7.2.

The California Reined Cow Horse Association (CRCHA) is an affiliate member of the National Reined Cow Horse Association (NRCHA) and is dedicated to preserving the vaquero tradition of training and exhibiting reined cow horses in California. Media coverage of the CRCHA, including its Premier Events (March derby, May Shoot Out and November futurity) and its horse shows (January, February, June, July and August) is central to the association's continuing efforts to promote and grow the reined cow horse sport in California. The purpose of this media policy is to set forth enforceable guidelines for appropriate content gathering and distribution at its Events. This policy also safeguards the CRCHA's relationship with its official photographer and official videographer while encouraging attention from the news media, both inside and outside the Western performance horse industry.

If you are a freelance photographers and/or videographers on specific marketing/promotion assignments from CRCHA sponsors, owners or riders you will be required to submit a Media Credential Request Form and adhere to CRCHA Media Policy guidelines.
