Entry Deadlines & Scratch Policy

Entries due Friday May 8th, entries accepted after with a \$30 late fee, until 12:00pm the day before the class runs. Entries after the draw are subject to cattle availability and will incur a \$30 late fee and be drawn last.

Scratches before midnight Sunday May 11th will receive a full refund. Scratches after midnight Sunday May 11th but before the draw will be responsible for the cattle fee. Scratches after the draw only the video and NRCHA fee will be refunded. Scratches must be in writing and confirmed by the show secretary. All changes and scratches must be sent to reanna@californiacowhorse.com

Show Information

Herd Practice; 8:00am start Wednesday May 13th. 96 slots available, entries after 96 will be placed on a waitlist, and will be moved up in the order it was received. Horse may only practice once, and the slot must be named. 24 slots reserved for 3 three year olds.

NRCHA rules apply.

Classes shown in the same box on the showbill run concurrently. When entering a concurrent class, pay only one cattle & video charge.

All owners & riders must be members of CRCHA. CRCHA Individual \$45, Family \$60, Youth \$25, or a Lifetime for \$450. All owners & riders must be a member of NRCHA for approved classes. You may join online or at the show.

CRCHA Classes: Jr Horse, open to horses 5 years and younger. Open Boxing, open to any horse and rider. Level 1 Non Pro Bridle, rider may not have placed first in year-end standings in any Non Pro Bridle class in any previous show year. Intermediate Non Pro Boxing, rider may not have placed first in year-end standings in any Non Pro Boxing class. Limited Non Pro Boxing; rider may not have finished in the top three in year-end standings in any Non Pro Boxing class

All entries must be submitted via MyEquinal, a confirmation with entry details will be sent after submission. If you do not receive a confirmation email, reach out to show secretary. If you need to make changes to your entry or scratch, email reanna@californiacowhorse.com. An entry confirmation list will be published on CHC Livscoring. Create an account on myequinal.app and sign up for text alerts to get notified when draws are posted.

All tabs must be closed out by end of day on Monday May 18th or a \$50 late fee will be applied. Cash, checks, and credit cards accepted. Credit cards incur a 3.5% fee.

Stalls, Shavings & RV Spaces Information:

Reservations open Friday May 1st and close Friday May 8th. Stall & RV reservations accepted after but availability not guaranteed. Verification List will be posted Saturday May 9th. Be sure to verify stall counts as stalls cancelled after Sunday May 10th are subject to a \$100 cancellation fee per stall.

Stalls – \$150 for duration. Day stalls not available.

Shavings – \$15/bag (2 bags minimum except tack stalls) Outside shavings not allowed.

RV spaces - \$50/night hookup or \$30/night dry camp. Spaces are first come, first serve.

Shoot Out Trophy Saddle Qualification

One trophy saddle will be awarded to the **Shoot Out Fence Champion**, and one trophy saddle will be awarded to the **Shoot Out Boxing Champion**. To qualify for the Spring Shoot Out, exhibitors must compete in **CRCHA classes at both Horse Show #4 and Horse Show #5**. **NRCHA classes do not count toward Shoot Out qualification**. No other qualification requirements apply.

Each horse/rider combination is limited to **one Shoot Out entry**. If a horse/rider combination qualifies in more than one class, they may only participate in the Shoot Out one time.

Qualification is based on the **highest combined cow scores from Horse Shows #4 and #5**. In the event of a tie, all tied horse/rider combinations will qualify.

Fence Shoot Out Qualification

For fence classes, the **highest total cow score**, including ties, from Horse Shows #4 and #5 in the following CRCHA classes will qualify for the Fence Shoot Out:

Open Bridle, Level 1 Open Bridle, Non Pro Bridle, Select Non Pro Bridle, Intermediate Non Pro Bridle, Level 1 Non Pro Bridle, Open Hackamore, Level 1 Open Hackamore, Open Junior Horse, Level 1 Open Junior Horse, Non Pro Hackamore, Non Pro Junior Horse, Open Two Rein, Non Pro Two Rein, and Youth Cow Horse.

Boxing Shoot Out Qualification

For boxing classes, the **top three total cow scores**, including ties, from Horse Shows #4 and #5 in the following CRCHA classes will qualify for the Boxing Shoot Out:

Youth Boxing, Non Pro Boxing, Select Non Pro Boxing, Intermediate Non Pro Boxing, and Limited Non Pro Boxing.

Open Boxing and Box Drive are not included in the Shoot Out.
